In our first quarter, we grew our team and welcomed Kim Vo as our assistant managing editor. She will lead our contributing writers' program and make it possible for us to mentor and publish even more first-person Reflections by veterans and military families.

This year, we've partnered with the Medill School of Journalism at Northwestern to publish a "beat desert" case study exploring the intersection of military bases and news deserts. This novel research will help us expand our programs and build on our 2023 findings with the University of Chicago, which explored how the decline in military reporting jeopardizes national security.


